VOTING CORNER

The last day to register to vote for the General Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 is on **Tuesday, October 17, 2023**. Visit the NJ Voter Information Portal to check your registration status, or fill out your voter registration application online at [NJ DOS - Division of Elections - Register to Vote! \(state.nj.us\)](#).

In-person early voting allows registered voters to cast their ballot in person, using a voting machine, during the designated voting period prior to Election Day. The in-person early voting period is **October 28th - November 5th**. LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

AREA 1*
VISTA'S/LAKEVIEW

Public Works will begin collecting leaves in October through January. The schedule may be modified at any time due to personnel, equipment and inclement weather. **Please adhere to the schedule of your area for leaf collection. Leaves are to be placed out only the week before your scheduled pickup day.** It is especially important that leaves are not placed at the curb many days before scheduled pickup days, as rain makes the leaves wet and difficult to collect, and presents a safety hazard to Eastampton staff and other residents.

RESIDENT CORNER

Chapter 145- Pet Waste

§ 145-5 Nuisances by pets.

A.

Private property. No person owning, harboring, keeping or in charge of any pet shall cause, suffer or allow such pet to soil, defile, defecate on or commit any nuisance on any private property without the permission of the owner of the property and without immediately removing all feces deposited by such pet in a sanitary manner.

B.

Public property. No person owning, harboring, keeping or in charge of any pet shall cause, suffer or allow such pet to soil, defile, defecate on or commit any nuisance on any public property or place whatsoever without immediately removing all feces deposited by such pet in a sanitary manner.


