## ORDINANCE 2022-15 TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON BURLNGTON COUNTY

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EASTAMPTON TO AMEND CHAPTER 250 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO ADDRESS FEES FOR USAGE OF TOWNSHIP FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Township recognizes the need to continually address standards and requirements for the use of Township facilities; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Eastampton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 250-2 of the Township Code of Eastampton shall be amended as follows:

The following shall be added to Section 250-2 which addresses "Recreation Fees;"

Type Use of Township Recreation Building	Minimum Fee \$25/hour for residents \$50/hour for nonresidents \$250 security deposit	Maximum Fee \$50/hour for residents \$100/hour for nonresidents \$500 security deposit
Use of Buttonwood Park Gazebo	\$10/hour for residents \$25/hour for nonresidents \$100 security deposit	\$25/hour for residents \$50/hour for nonresidents \$200 security deposit
Use of Cliver Park Gazebo	\$10/hour for residents \$25/hour for nonresidents \$100 security deposit	\$25/hour for residents \$50/hour for nonresidents \$200 security deposit
Use of Veterans Park Pavilion	\$10/hour for residents \$25/hour for nonresidents \$100 security deposit	\$25/hour for residents \$50/hour for nonresidents \$200 security deposit

**SECTION 2.** Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflict.

**SECTION 3.** Severability. If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not effect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The governing body of the Township of

Eastampton declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section and subsection thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 4.** Effective Date. The ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
